Light It Up

The Foundation has received \$52,000 from anonymous donors to purchase new holiday street lights for Colonial and Washington Avenues and other parts of downtown. These lights will replace the aging lights that are looking a bit sadder every year. This is donor-driven grant -- the lights have been selected by the donors and approved by the Town.

New Fund Account to Better Serve the Community

The Foundation has formally changed the name of the fund account that it has been using to purchase gift cards for local fool pantries to the **Community Crisis Fund**. This new fund will be dedicated to helping serve the needs of the community during emergencies.

Currently, the Foundation is raising money for the Community Crisis Fund to support our local food pantries during the holiday season.

Last year, in the midst of the pandemic, the Foundation surveyed community resources and found that food insecurity



challenged many of our neighbors. Thanks to you, the Foundation raised and donated over \$10,000 worth of gift cards to our local food pantries. Gift cards enable clients to purchase items not available at the pantries based on their individual needs.
