Did you know that the Colonial Beach Foundation is now the Colonial Beach Community Foundation (CBCF)? A reorganization in 2018 places



On March 18, the CBCF filed paperwork with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to transfer the license of broadcast radio station WWER from Fredericksburg Christian School (FCS) to the CBCF. FCS no longer wants the license and is community support, and embraces programs and activities throughout the surrounding area, not just within the Town of Colonial Beach. 
